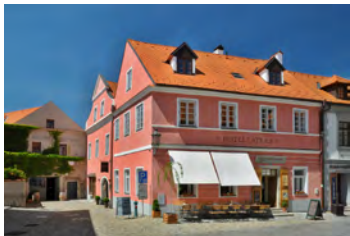

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Once a communist stronghold, the Czech Republic has now become a hub of cultural offerings, historical tours and classical, ornate buildings. Hotel Latran embodies the very essence of the new Czech Republic – a small, but perfectly decorated hotel, it offers 16 rooms either furnished with modern touches or in a more traditional period style. With a distinct medieval core, the hotel comprises of two houses from the 15th Century, previously owned by members of the bourgeoisie of the kingdom of Bohemia. One of the older, wooden houses is still part of the hotel's make-up, and creates a unique place to stay when visiting this eclectic country.

Proud of its medieval roots, the hotel has kept some of its more archaic touches, with the stencil markings that decorate the walls inside Hotel Latran inspired by the building's original paintings. Another standout feature of Hotel Latran is its two restaurants, which connect the hotel with its local community. Whilst Cafe Studl is steeped in history, as the first cafe in southern Bohemia that baked and sold strudels, it is Pub DEPO that stands out – selling traditional Czech cuisine and beer, the venue is home to live music performances on the terrace in summer, bring a modern touch to an enchanting, medieval town.
